

GUMC Preschool COVID-19 Safety Protocols for our 2020 Class



Classes in our building will have limited activities during the school day and no more than 30 students will be present during school hours; we are enrolling no more than 30 students

To ensure proper social distancing, class size will be limited to 12 students per class, and classes will be staggered

Teachers and other adults present are required to wear a mask on premises (for students, we know it would be difficult)

Play objects (toys) will be divided into 2 groups so that a "clean" set of objects can be quickly replaced by disinfected ones for the next class; all objects and surfaces to be disinfected after use

Proper handwashing & sanitizing will be stressed, and students also will be instructed as to how to wipe down and sanitize equipment after each use

Students will be required to provide some supplies of their own to avoid sharing. A detailed list will be provided, but will include such non-disposable items as markers, safety scissors, crayons, and pencils

Due to government restrictions and recommendations, these protocols could change at any time; we will always follow all applicable governmental rules and recommendations
